14. Operational support for campaigns: The total budget for campaign operational costs is US\$18,944,500. Of this total amount, US\$4,570,000 is held by MoH/NPHCDA as unspent balance from 2013 Yellow Fever campaign grant; and, US\$1,900,000 is held by UNICEF country office as unspent balance from 2013 MenAfriVac campaign. Thus, GAVI will make cash disbursement of only US\$12,474,500. This amount will be disbursed in cash through WHO and UNICEF. Country will need to contact the local WHO and UNICEF offices to arrange for the utilisation of GAVI funds to support the operational costs of the campaign.
