# Correction to Co-Financing amounts 2014-2015

Further to our letter dated 23 November 2012 (reference GAVI/12/252/JT/AK) and based on discussions with officials from your ministry in Geneva and mutual agreement, we wish to inform you of a correction to the co-financing amounts for Pentavalent vaccine. This will be addressed in years 2014 and 2015.

Due to a regrettable calculation error, GAVI underestimated the co-financing requirements for 2013, 2014 and 2015. As discussed with the ministry recently, in order to address this calculation error, the amount for 2013 will remain unchanged and the difference will be added to the co-financing amounts in 2014 and 2015 as shown below. For your reference, the co-financing requirement for Sri Lanka in 2012 was US\$ 761,000.

Please find below a table that shows the amounts that were communicated as well as the amounts corrected in accordance with the GAVI Co-Financing Policy. These corrected amounts will be included in the Annual Progress Report (APR).
