Dear Minister,

Re: Renewal of Health Systems Strengthening Support for India

We are writing in relation to India's renewal request to Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, for Health Systems Strengthening (HSS) support, which was submitted to the Gavi Secretariat following the Joint Appraisal mission in November 2018.

Following Gavi's review of the renewal request during the High Level Review Panel of 29-30 January 2019, we are pleased to inform you that **Gavi has approved India's renewal request for HSS support for years 2019 and 2020**, as per the following Decision Letter.

Gavi has endorsed the five-year HSS programme budget of USD 102 million (section 7), in response to a letter from the Government of India, dated 24 May 2017, to request for re-appropriation of funds from commodity support for Rotavirus vaccine to additional budget for HSS phase 2, in the amount of USD 2.2 million. The Annual Amount for Year 5 shall be approved following the next annual renewal request in 2020.

Finally, we reiterate that the provisions of the Partnership Framework Agreement (PFA) Annex 6 shall apply to all Gavi programme funding and Decision Letters form an integral part of the PFA. The Gavi Board's decision to provide support for India's HSS programme is also subject to the provisions of Annex 6 of the PFA, in particular the commitment of the Government of India to provide additional costs required as well as sustain the programme after the transition out of Gavi support, and to implement the programme as set out in the approved Performance Framework.
