- 2 Korea has pledged US\$ 200 million in the form of a combination of financial and in-kind contribution for 2021 and 2022
- 3 Includes US\$ 6.25m of pro-rata share of un-allocated AMC-PCV funds
- 4 Germany's total contribution of EUR 1.080m includes: EUR 900m towards COVAX AMC vaccine purchase (EUR 100m announced in 2020; EUR 620m committed at G7 Early Leaders' Summit in Feb. 2021 together with EUR 100m for obtaining vaccines for humanitarian purposes via the COVAX AMC humanitarian buffer; and EUR80m confirmed at the G20-EU Global Health Summit in May 2021), and EUR 180m towards vaccine logistics (UNICEF).

- 8 The United States has committed \$2.5 billion towards COVAX's 2021 goals (having contributed \$2 billion as of Q2 2021). At the June summit, the United States reaffirmed its full \$4 billion pledge. In support of additional goals through 2022, the remaining \$1.5 billion will support both procurement and delivery. Of the \$4 billion total, \$500 million will support vaccine delivery in 2021 and 2022.
- 9 Committing up to US\$ 2.5 million through a contribution and employee matching programme, with a minimum contribution of US\$1 million. A Swiss foundation wishing to remain anonymous is offering to match the US\$1 million contribution
- 10 A Swiss foundation wishing to remain anonymous has committed up to CHF 15 million in additional match funds to continue to encourage the private sector, philanthropy and high-net worth individuals to contribute towards the Gavi COVAX AMC. This new challenge will run until early June, with contributions between US\$ 100,000 and US\$ 1 million eligible for a match
- 11 Funding advised by anonymous donor in support of COVAX AMC Project, a CAF USA Project

- 13 On 2 June 2021, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation made a pledge of US\$ 50m
- 14 Contribution is contingent on a duly executed grant agreement with Gates Philanthropy Partners
- 15 Google.org has donated US\$15 million in Ad credits to Gavi. Longer term, Google.org engineers will also support Gavi's broader innovation agenda.
- 16 Mastercard has pledged US\$25 million to support equitable vaccine delivery and digital solutions related to COVID-19. Through its donation platform Mastercard is incentivizing participation of consumers by matching donations made through 16 May 2021 up to US\$ 4 million. Donations made with a Citi Mastercard during this same time period will also be matched up to \$1 million. A portion of Mastercard's contribution will be matched by the Gavi Matching Fund for an additional US\$10 million. And MasterCard is also contributing up to US\$1 million to the Duke and Duchess of Sussex initiative.
- 17 PagerDuty, Russel Reynolds Associates, Salesforce and Workday have mobilised collectively US\$910,000 to seed a matching campaign, supported by Go Give One campaign and Pledge 1% initiative.
- 18 In a parallel effort to help meet urgent demand for COVID-19 vaccines in lower-income countries, Vax Live campaign co-chairs Prince Harry and Meghan, The Duke and Duchess of Sussex, urged the public to contribute to COVAX through the Mastercard donation platform. Donations will be matched by the Seadream Family Foundation for up to US\$1 million, together with MasterCard and other partners.
- 19 Funding advised by The ThistleDown Foundation in support of The ThistleDown Foundation COVAX Project, a CAF Canada Project
- 20 TikTok's US\$ 5m contribution is matched by BMGF with a US\$ 5m contribution to Gavi in support of Covid vaccine delivery and other Gavi activities complementary to COVAX AMC.
- 21 In addition to the contribution, Toyota Tsusho donated 5 Vaccine Land Cruisers vehicles.
