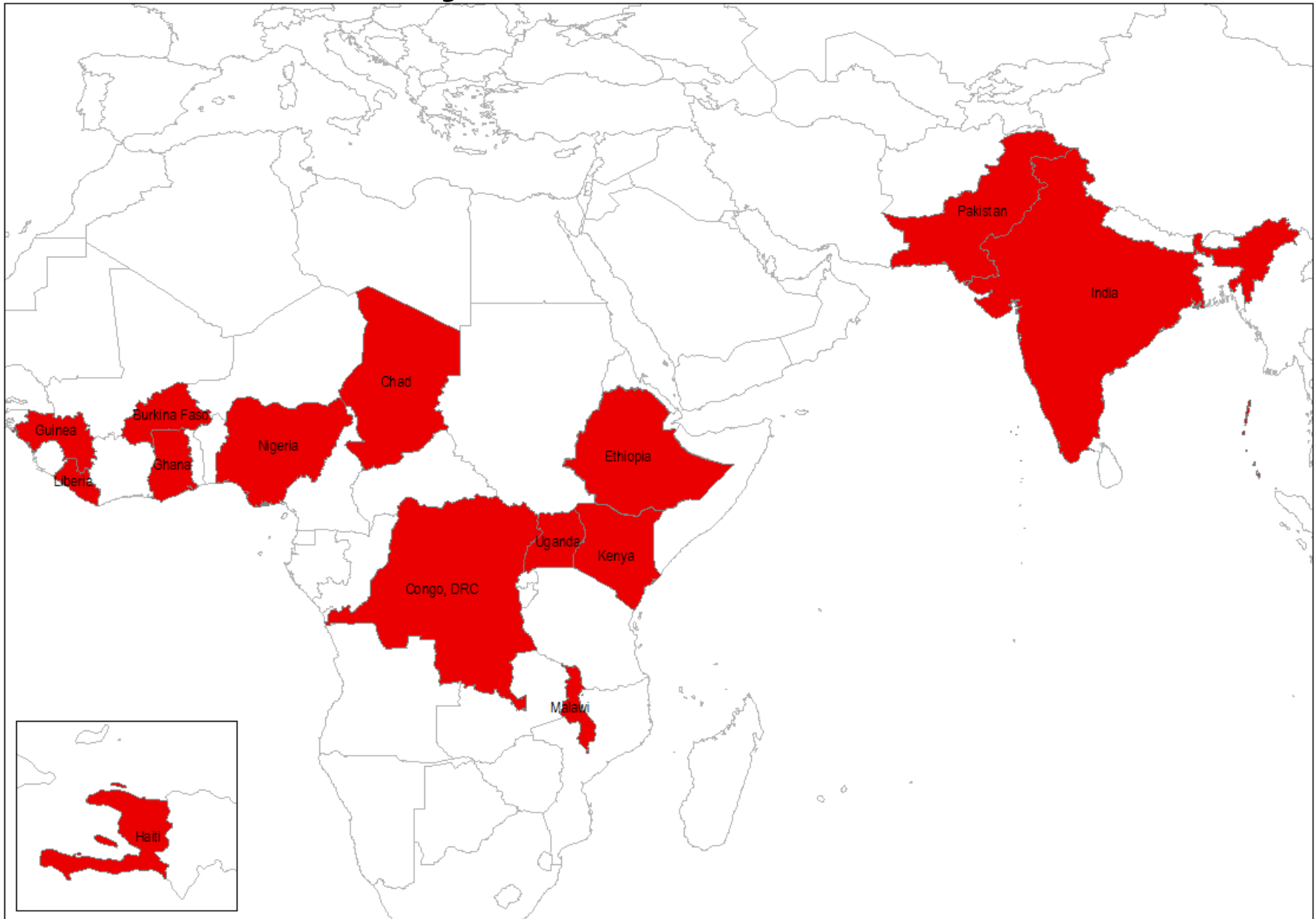

33% of CSO platform members **operate health facilities.**

23% of surveyed CSOs are direct service providers of immunizations,
with more than **1.5 million children immunized** by just 30 organizations.

82% of CSO platform members provide
community mobilization services for
flyer distribution, in-person visits
with families, and **tracking clients**.

- **Three million home visits were made**
- **1.5 million children were immunized**
- **5,314 health workers were trained on immunization**
- **45,665 volunteers were trained on community mobilization for immunization**
