Former Gavi- eligible countries

Post-transition support to former Gavi-eligible countries to be institutionalised

Approach focusing on:

Political advocacy, technical assistance, innovation, access to pricing, and catalytic financial support to jumpstart vaccine introductions

Never Gavi- eligible countries

GNI per capita <US\$ 4,000

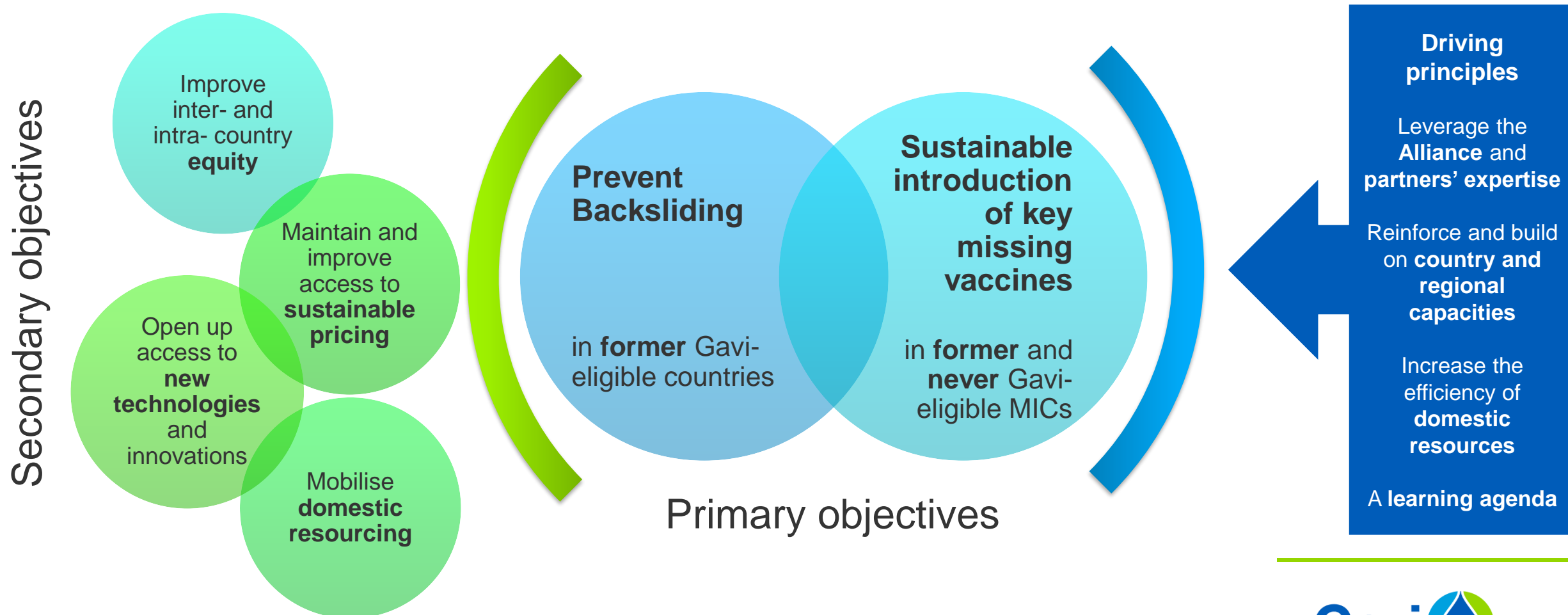
- Many of these countries face similar challenges as former Gavi-eligible countries.
- To explore options to engage with these countries on **the same set of modalities**

GNI per capita US\$ 4,000 - US\$ 6,000

- To also explore options to engage with these countries.
- However based on needs, the **modalities of engagement may be different**

Resource allocation: No more than 3.0% of Gavi 5.0 planned expenditure

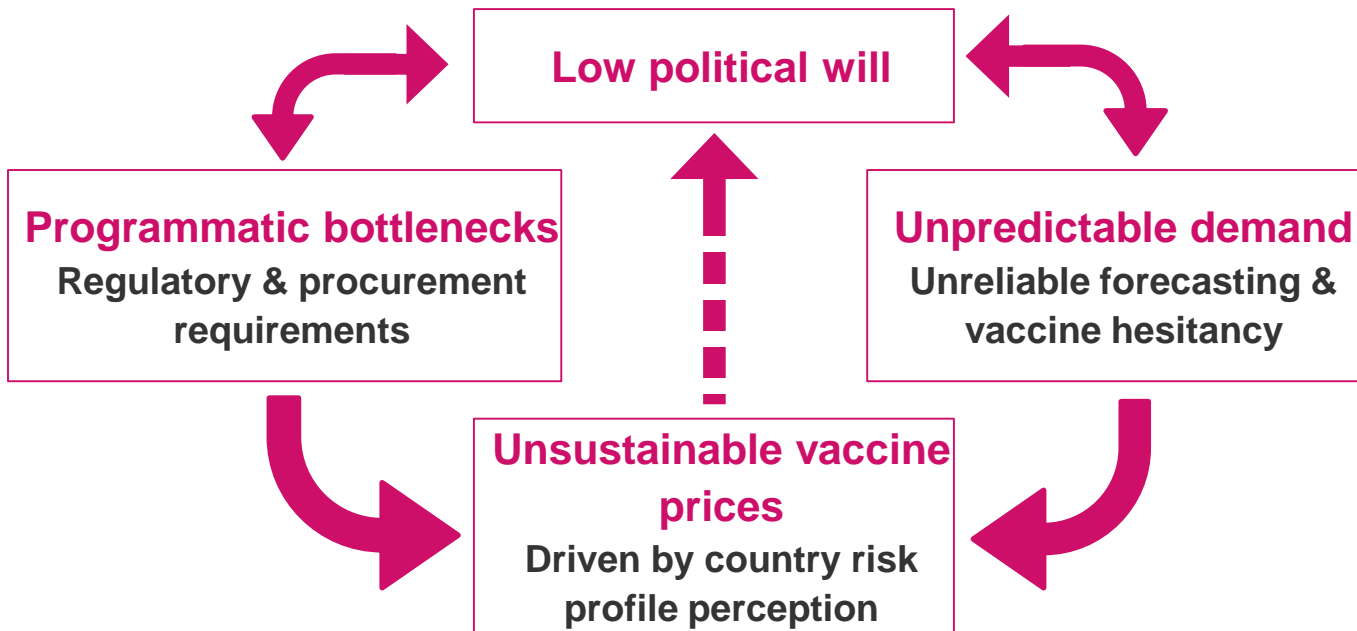

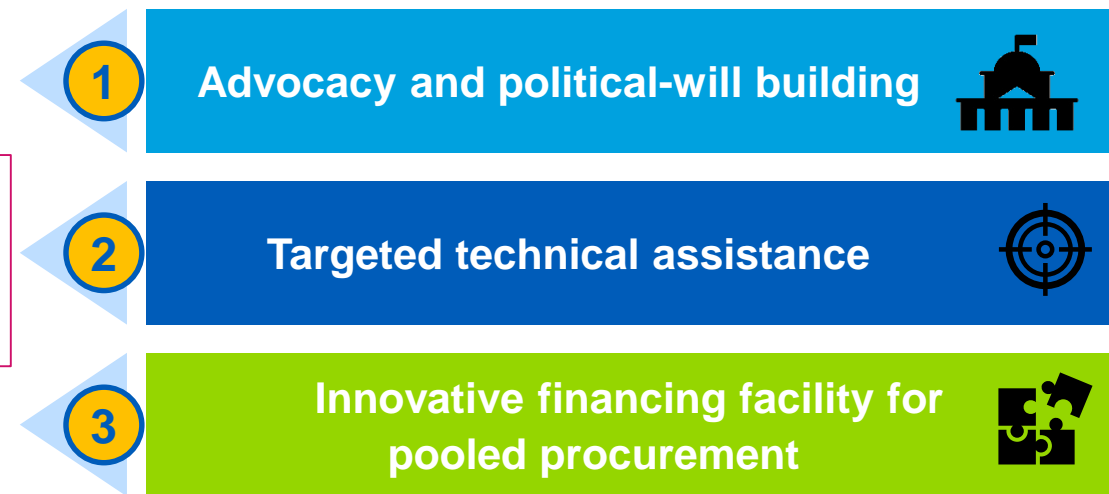
What causes backsliding and prevents new vaccine introductions?

Stakeholder consultations have identified interdependent drivers



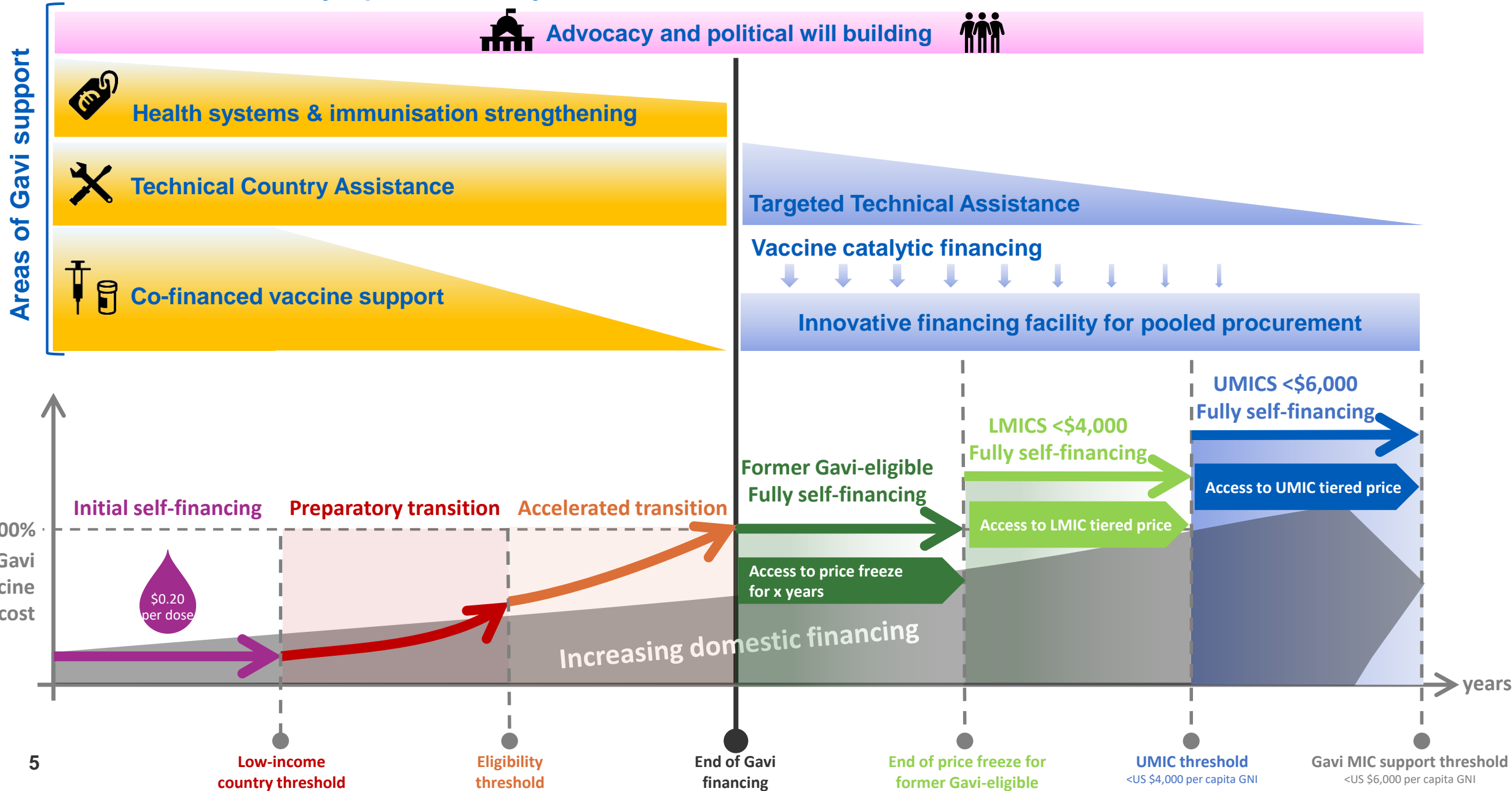
