- Rise in temperatures, more extreme weather, droughts and heat waves, changes in precipitation, stronger storms and hurricanes, rising sea levels



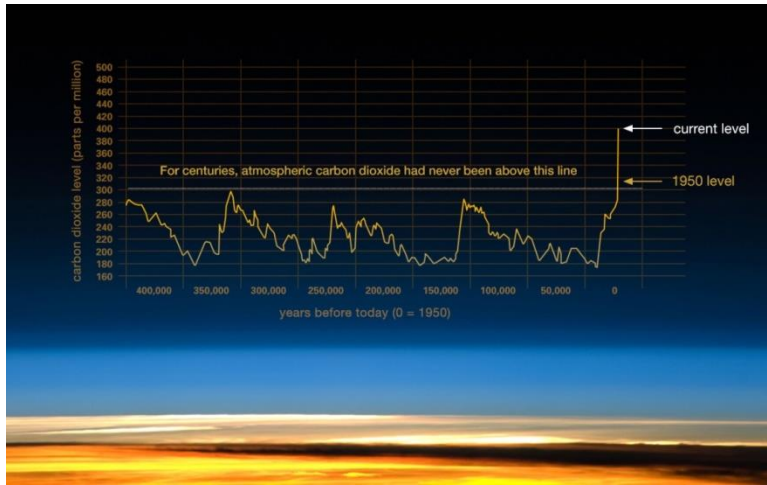
How does this relate to health and other areas?
