- **17. Financial Clarifications:** The Country shall provide the following clarifications to Gavi*: *Failure to provide the financial clarifications requested may result in Gavi withholding further disbursements
- a) The Ministry should confirm the funding expended on Phase 2. The Ministry of Health should submit to Gavi a formal proposal for use of any surplus funds on unexpended funds. Unexpended funds should preferably be used for Phase 3 activities and should only be expended otherwise based on an approved proposal for reprogramming of left over funds for critical EPI activities by Gavi.
- b) The Ministry should provide justification for the significant increase in per diem expenditures compared to Phases 1 and 2.

18. Other conditions:

The country must provide satisfactory responses to all IRC comments, as communicated in the information letter dated 2 July 2015, before funds can be disbursed.
