This will support the health sector financing strategy for UHC that will be prepared next year. This will complement technical efficiency work via PBF and RBF to drive vaccination and well-baby monitoring for the poorest families using the Social Register supported under the Social Safety Nets project financed by the Bank. WBG supports implementation of the action plan that will come from the initial health financing diagnostic note being prepared by government with P4H support (mission ending week of 23 October). The objective is to deepen the dialogue on the allocative efficiency of government's financing. The 2015 PER found that the MoH budget allocated 60 percent to tertiary care, 21 percent to primary care, and four percent to preventive care (e.g. immunization, reproductive health, malaria). This is deeply regressive given that high-impact interventions are not equally distributed: the 2016 MICS shows that children fully immunized ranges from 11.5 to 87.7 percent. Regions (wilayas) covered by the WB-financed project have 30.9 (Guidimagha) and 51.1 percent. Although Mauritania is only in the preparatory transition phase, there is also a need for preparation of a graduation strategy to allow the government budget to prepare for additional financing of high-impact interventions like immunization.
